


About Us

El Campeon Farms was established in 2000 as a training base for high performance show jumpers and the family's string of hunters, equitation and young horses. For the 2008 Olympics, Will Simpson and El Campeon's Carlsson Vom Dach, were named to the US Team and helped to secure the gold medal in team show jumping. ince then the farm has evolved into a training facility for multiple disciplines including Working Equitation.

El Campeon Farms is the breed steward for the Heritage Horses of Santa Cruz Island, a rare and unique Spanish Colonial breed that was removed from the Island in 1998. Through their partnership with renown geneticists and veterinarians they have been able to preserve the breed and add to its numbers.

Since then the farm has evolved into a training facility for multiple disciplines including Working Equitation. ECF also serves as the base for the Preservation of the <u>Santa Cruz Island Horse</u> project. Working Equitation quickly became the ideal sport for the SCI horses. Their gentle nature, expressive gaits, and friendly personalites have helped them earn a favorable reputation within the Working Equitation world as well as the Western Dressage and Classical Dressage arenas.

COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS

USAWE RATED SHOW

This show will be conducted and judged in accordance with the United States Rules for Working Equitation, Revision 7.2, MARCH 20, 2024. The rules can be found at the following site: <u>https://usawe.org/rules.</u>

It is the competitor's responsibility to read and understand the rules prior to the competition.

MEMBERSHIP

All riders participating in any USAWE recognized competitions must be a current USAWE member prior to competition or pay a \$50 non-member fee (for each competition they enter). Non-members may not compete in Championshp Shows.

Competitors interested in being eligible for lifetime medal awards and year-end awards must be USAWE members.

HORSE RECORDING

All competing horses must be recorded with USAWE in advance of the show. A onetime fee of \$30 per horse includes lifetime performance tracking.

HOW TO ENTER

Our online entry form can be found on our website (<u>www.ecfwe.com</u>) when the entries have opened on <u>May 31st at 12pm</u>. Once you complete the form you will receive an automated copy of your entry which will serve as your confirmation. Paypal invoices will be sent out two days before the closing date and will need to be paid-in-full within 48 hrs. If not paid in time, your spot will be released to the waiting list entries.

ENTRIES OPEN/CLOSE

Entries open six weeks before the show on May 31, 2024. The entry form will be published on our show website, www.ecfwe.com. **Our shows usually fill up within 48 hours so don't** wait to sign up. Entries accepted on a first come, first served basis.

Entries close two weeks before the show on May <u>June 21st</u>. Entries received after closing date will be subject to a \$20 late fee.



AWARDS CEREMONY

Level 1 awards ceremony will be held Saturday evening during our competitors dinner. Level 2-7 awards will be held Sunday afternoon after the speed phase is completed.

OVERALL AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st - 6th place in each level/division. Prizes will be awarded for 1st - 3rd place in each level/division.

PHASE AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st - 6th in each of the three phases.

HIGH SCORE

High point champion and reserve champion ribbons and prizes will be awarded to the highest scoring riders in each division. All phases must be completed successfully to qualify. Score is determined by averaging your dressage and EOH score.

BEST TURNOUT

Judge(s) will select the best dressed in these categories: Western, Dressage, and Other (includes all other styles of tack) horse and rider pairs.

FAQs

CAN I BRING MY DOG?

While dogs are permitted we ask that you only bring your dog if no other option is available. Dogs must be on a leash at all times. Any dog /pet that disrupts an exhibitor's round will be required to pay the exhibitor their entry fee. Dog owners will be held financially and legally responsible for any injuries or damages caused by their pets.

CAN I RESERVE A TACK STALL?

Unfortunately we cannot offer tack stalls at this time. The horse trailers will be parked directly across form the stabling area for easy access to tack and equipment.

WHEN WILL I GET MY RIDE TIMES?

Competitor ride times usually go out a few days before the show. Once ride times are published and emailed out you may request a change if one is necessary.

WHEN WILL I RECIEVE MY EOH/SPEED MAPS?

EOH and speed maps are usually published the night before the show.

WILL THERE BE LUNCH AVAILABLE AT ECF?

Yes, there will be a taco/food vendor for lunch usually from 11am-2pm. PLEASE BRING CASH.

POLICY ON REFUNDS

Cancellation: If the entire event is canceled, a full refund minus the office fee will be issued within 14 days of cancellation.

Refund: If a registered participant withdraws from a USAWE-sponsored event, they must notify the event sponsor in writing prior to the start of the event. If the withdrawal is prior to the closing date, a full refund minus the office fee will be sent within 14 days. Entries are non-refundable after the closing date. Show management may be able to provide a refund minus the office fee on a case-by-case basis under one of the following conditions:

a. Withdrawal of a rider or horse is due to an injury, illness, or death. The withdrawal is accompanied by a veterinarian's or doctor's certificate.
b. If there is a wait list and the event manager is able to replace your entry.




A FEW THINGS TO REMEMBER

- please stay on designated paths only


DIRECTIONS TO SHOW ENTRANCE

 - Exit Westlake Blvd, TURN RIGHT
- heading north on 101
 - Exit Westlake Blvd TURN LEFT
- Travel 1.5 Miles, TURN RIGHT on Potrero Rd.
- Travel about 4 Miles and TURN RIGHT onto Thorton Rd. (Dirt Road)
- After 100yds TURN LEFT through the first set of metal gates. DRIVE SLOWLY and follow cones to parking.
